Use Sophisticated Finishes real Iron Metallic Surfacer and Rust Antiquing Solution to give an antique-look to a gold painted paper mache reindeer and unfinished wood candle holders. Create a unique holiday centerpiece that will be welcome year after year.

PROJECT TIP:
Use clear finish to stop the rust reaction when the desired affect has been achieved.

INSTRUCTIONS:

For both-

1. Use brush to coat all surfaces with Iron Metallic Surfacer. Allow to dry then add a second coat, covering well. Allow second coat to dry at least 8 to 10 hours before next step.
2. Spray on Rust Antiquing Solution. Stop rusting reaction when desired look is achieved by spraying on clear finish in a well-ventilated area.
3. Add a piece a ribbon tied in a simple bow around the reindeer's neck and embellish with a holiday floral spray.
