Small Pewter Vase

SKILL LEVEL: (1 being the easiest, 5 being of highest difficulty)

TIME TO COMPLETE:
30 min. (plus drying time between coats)



Pewter, Copper and an authentic rusted finish gives new life to a painted ceramic floral container using Sophisticated Finishes Metallic Surfacers, a latex-based paint containing real metal flakes.

PROJECT TIP:
Rust Antiquing Solution will not react with Pewter. Use Copper or another color of Sophisticated Finishes Metallic Surfacers to add highlights which will rust on the Pewter container.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Use foam brush to apply Pewter to entire outside of container. Allow to dry and apply a second coat.
2. Use brush to apply Copper in creases in vase. While paint is wet, carefully spray Rust Antiquing Solution onto Copper to create real rust reaction.
3. Use table knife to cut floral foam to fit inside container. Insert greenery, shaping stems as desired.
